2017 FALL CITIZEN'S POLICE ACADEMY IS FILLED

I would like to personally thank the Parsippany residents who submitted their applications to attend the Parsippany Police Department's 2017 Fall Citizen's Police Academy. The class is now full. However, we will continue to accept applications until August 25, 2017 as previously stated. Those applicants will be contacted, in the order that they are received, should there be any cancellations. We will also keep those applications on file and place them on a wait list for the 2018 Spring Academy. After August 25, 2017 we will not accept any more applications until we announce the 2018 Spring Academy.

The Clean Communities Program **has been in operation for approximately twenty-five years and is funded through grant money from the State of New Jersey's Department of Environmental Protection.**

The seasonal employees range in ages from 14 through 22. Most of them are returning students who have worked for the Township in previous summers. Some of the older students work on recycling trucks, paving crews, storm basin crews, and with the engineers in the Engineering Department. The younger students work on various cleanups throughout the town, the recycling yard, as well as our yearly Rockaway River cleanup.

This year we received \$108,397., and we were able to hire twenty-two employees. The grant money is also used to buy supplies and equipment which are used by the employees for the cleanups, and to provide litter abatement and recycling education in our schools.





On July 11, 2017, the Woman's Club of Parsippany-Troy Hills held their 36th Annual Tee-Off for Education Golf Classic and Luncheon at the Knoll Country Club. The Knoll is one of the finest golf courses in the state and ran an exceptional event. I have always supported the Woman's Club for their altruistic efforts. This year, the Woman's Club provided 10 \$1,000 scholarships to high school students at Parsippany High and Parsippany Hills. In addition, they hold an annual spelling bee, give out Middle School Citizenship Awards, Elementary School Reading Awards and support Girls' Career Institute Delegates and Project Graduation. Their donations have helped the GFWC Success for Survivors Scholarship which assists those impacted by domestic violence to pursue higher education. Throughout the year, the Woman's Club is involved with Jersey Battered Women's Service and helps with their campaign against domestic abuse. Child Abuse is another topic that is supported the Woman's Club. All of this was made possible by the grand event held today at the Knoll.
