

**NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE
AND STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the ordinance entitled “A CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$1,500,000 FROM THE SEWER UTILITY FUND OF THE TOWNSHIP FOR THE INSPECTION, CLEANING AND REPLACEMENT AS REQUIRED OF THE TROY MEADOWS INTERCEPTOR” was duly introduced and passed upon first reading at a regular meeting of the governing body of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey (the “Township”), on November 3, 2016. Further notice is hereby given that said ordinance appropriates \$1,500,000 from the Sewer Utility Fund of the Township for the inspection and cleaning of the Troy Meadows Interceptor (the “Interceptor”) and for the reconstruction or replacement, as applicable, of any portion of the Interceptor, including all work, materials and accessories necessary therefor and incidental thereto;

(ii) said ordinance will be considered for final passage and adoption, after public hearing thereon, at a regular meeting of governing body to be held at the held at the Municipal Building at 1001 Parsippany Road, in said Township on November 22, 2016 at 7:30o'clock p.m.; and

(iii) copies of said ordinance may be obtained without cost to any member of the general public who shall request the same at the office of the Township Clerk, at the Municipal Building at 1001 Parsippany Road, Parsippany-Troy Hills, New Jersey between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
