ORDINANCE NO. 2017:22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS, MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND MODIFYING CHAPTER 372, TAXICABS AND LIMOUSINES, SECTION 372-8, TAXICAB OWNER'S LICENSE; AND CHAPTER A445, FEES COMPILATION, SECTION A445-39, LIMOUSINES, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills (the "Township") regulates the licensing and operation of limousines operating within its jurisdiction for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Township requires limousine operators to attain maintain licensure in order to operate for-hire limousine services, which requires the Township to receive, review and process initial and renewal license applications; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds and declares that it is in the best interest of health, safety and welfare of its residents to ensure that all administrative costs associated with the processing of initial and renewal limousine license applications are borne by the applicant; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council desires to encourage compliance with statutory and regulatory limousine safety requirements, and to discourage the use of Township limousine licenses for operations outside of its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills, Morris County, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 372, Taxicabs and Limousines, Section 372-8, Limousine owner's license, Subsection I, Administrative fee, of the Code of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills is hereby amended as follows:

- I. Administrative fee. Each applicant shall pay an administrative fee of \$800 for an initial limousine owner's license application or an application to renew an expired limousine owner's license. The administrative fee for each renewal of an unexpired limousine owner's license shall be \$400.

SECTION 2. Chapter A445, Fees Compilation, Section A445-39, Limousines, Subsection D, Administrative fees, of the Code of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills is hereby amended as follows:

D. Administrative fees.

(1) Administrative fee for initial license or renewal of expired license: \$800.

(2) Administrative fee for annual renewal of unexpired license: \$400.

SECTION 3. All actions of the Township taken prior to the date of adoption hereof contemplated by this Ordinance are hereby ratified and approved.

SECTION 4 If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
