ORDINANCE NO. 2018:09

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS, MORRIS COUNTY,
NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 326, SEWAGE DISPOSAL
SYSTEMS, INDIVIDUAL, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS RELATED TO APPLICATIONS FOR AN
INITIAL LICENSE TO OPERATE A SUBSURFACE SEWAGE
DISPOSAL SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills (the "Township") is responsible for enforcing Chapter 9A of Title 7 of the New Jersey Administrative Code (Department of Environmental Protection) entitled "Standards for Individual Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems," as amended, which is currently codified at N.J.A.C. 7:9A-1.1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:9A-1.1 et seq., the Township has adopted ordinances requiring an owner or occupant of any property not connected to the Township sewer system to obtain a license from the Township to operate, or for the continued operation of, a subsurface sewage disposal system on the property; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to amend Chapter 326, Sewage Disposal Systems, Individual, to require an owner or occupant of any property not connected to the Township sewer system to apply for such license with a minimum of 90 days from receipt of the notice thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds and declares that this amendment is necessary for the promotion and assurance of the proper operation, management, and maintenance of such sewage disposal systems in the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Parsippany, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 326-5(B) of the Township Code, License Required, is hereby amended as follows:

§326-5 License required.

- B. Initial license. The Township Department of Health and Human Services shall notify all owners of property not connected to the Township sewer system in writing of the requirement to obtain a license to operate, or for continued operation of, a subsurface sewage disposal system. Said notice shall include a copy of this chapter and shall specify that the deadline to apply for an initial license which shall be at a minimum of 90 days from receipt of the notice. Applications for an initial license to operate for an existing subsurface sewage disposal system shall include the fees, documents and certifications required for the renewal of a license to operate as set forth in this section.

Section 2. All other provisions of the Ordinances of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills not amended herein remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
